Biografie

Jakob de Haan is Professor of Political Economy at the University of Groningen in The Netherlands. He has been Head of Research of De Nederlandsche Bank and also Scientific Director of SOM, the graduate school and research institute of the faculty of Economics and Business of the University of Groningen.

Jakob de Haan graduated at the University of Groningen, where he also received his Ph.D. He has published extensively on issues like public debt, monetary policy, central bank independence, political and economic freedom and European integration.

He is member of the editorial board of Public Choice, European Union Politics, and the Journal of International Money and Finance. He has been editor of the European Journal of Political Economy, and President of the European Public Choice Society. De Haan has also been visiting professor at the Free University Berlin (2003/4), Kiel Institute (2002, 2010), and the University of Munich (1999). He is also research fellow of CESifo.
